FESTIVAL BACKGROUND & FEES

The Salem Art Fair & Festival serves as a fundraiser for the programs and operations of the Salem Art Association, a nonprofit organization dedicated to art education, art appreciation, and historic preservation. As Oregon's largest community visual-arts organization, its operations include the Bush Barn Art Center's galleries, Bush House Museum and The Annex.

Now in its 76th year, the Salem Art Fair & Festival is an annual three-day event sponsored by the Salem Art Association. This outdoor event is held in beautiful Bush's Pasture Park in the heart of Salem. With more than 200 participating visual artists, music and performances, hands-on activities for children and much more, the three-day festival draws an estimated 25,000 visitors annually. The Salem Art Fair & Festival brings many diverse populations together to celebrate and enjoy all forms of art.

The Salem Art Fair & Festival is a major event in the Pacific Northwest, with a long history of providing high-caliber performers with tremendous public exposure.
